Gold Alert
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Traumatic Arrest/CPR * Airway/respiratory compromise or any intubated patient * GCS \leq 8 * SBP < 100 * HR \geq 120 or \leq 60 * Penetrating injury: head, neck, back, chest, abdomen, pelvis, or extremities proximal to elbow/knee * Amputation, crushed, mangled, de-gloved or pulseless extremity proximal to wrist/ankle * Uncontrolled hemorrhage, vascular injury, or tourniquet in place * Blood product administration for perfusion
Trauma Alert
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * GCS 9-13 or LOC > 5 minutes * Chest wall or pelvis instability * Paralysis * Burn > 20% TBSA
Trauma Consult
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Age over 55 * Pregnancy >20 weeks (may meet OB alert criteria) * Need for Trauma Clinic follow-up (Mon/Thurs) * TBI with loss of consciousness < 5 mins and GCS is 14-15 * TBI (EDH, SDH, SAH) with anticoagulants (ASA, Plavix, Coumadin, Pradaxa, etc.)

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
